Pursuant to Section 4 of the Natural Gas Act and Part 154 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("FERC" or "Commission") regulations, ANR Pipeline Company ("ANR") submits herewith a proposed substitute Part 1 - Table of Contents, v.2.1.0 ("Table of Contents"), to be part of its FERC Gas Tariff, Third Revised Volume No. 1 ("Tariff"). ANR is submitting the Table of Contents, v.2.1.0, to revise a listing for Section No. 4.20 to "Reserved for Future Use." ANR respectfully requests that Table of Contents, v.2.1.0, filed herein be effective November 1, 2010.

Statement of the Nature, Reasons, and Basis for Filing

On October 29, 2010, in Docket No. RP11-1474-000, ANR submitted a filing to add new tariff sections, and accordingly, to update the Table of Contents of its Tariff to reflect the addition of certain negotiated rate agreements ("October 29 Filing).² The tariff sections proposed in the October 29 Filing were subsequently approved by letter order to be effective November 1, 2010.

On December 3, 2010, in Docket No. RP11-1595-000, ANR filed to update its Tariff ("December 3 Filing") with revisions approved in the November 24 Letter Order issued in RP10-940-000.³ The November 24 Letter Order required that the accepted tariff sheet revisions be incorporated into ANR's section-based Tariff, effective September 30, 2010.⁴ In part, the December 3 Filing revised the Table of Contents listing for Section No. 4.20 from "Statement of Surcharges – Liquids" to "Reserved for Future Use."

As a result of the tariff revisions submitted in the December 3 Filing, it is necessary for ANR to revise the Table of Contents approved as part of the October 29 Filing. As such, the Table of

On July 31, 2010, the Commission issued an order which accepted and suspended these revised tariff sheets to become effective January 1, 2011, or some earlier date if so ordered, subject to the outcome of a technical conference. The November 24 Letter Order approved tariff sheet revisions submitted in the July 1 Filing to be effective August 1, 2010, and further directed ANR to update its section-based Tariff with the revisions accepted in the order.

Contents, included herein at Appendix A, has been updated to list Section 4.20 as "Reserved for Future Use." ANR respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Table of Contents, to be effective November 1, 2010, consistent with the date the Commission accepted the October 29 Filing.

ANR respectfully requests that the Commission accept Table of Contents, v.2.1.0, to be effective November 1, 2010. ANR further requests that the Commission grant any waivers necessary to allow for this effective date.
